The final doctoral regulations

The much discussed article 15, regarding the 30 ECTS has passed legislation in the latest OR VU meeting. 30 ECTS translates to 105 days to spend on your education. All PhDs have until April 1st 2015 to fill out and hand in their form 1. Otherwise the new PhD rules apply. The only exception is when you are unable to do this before April 1st, then the old rules apply to your PhD trajectory by default.

Faculties are responsible for the availability of enough courses and that time and money are available for all PhDs. One of these courses must be the Scientific Integrity course.

Also; you can get exemptions for (part of) the 30 ECTS (the rules are determined by the faculty). There will be an evaluation in spring 2016 to determine any issues and to determine efficacy of article 15.

So again, please make sure you fill out your [form 1](#) before April 1st 2015

From the registrar's office (bureau pedel)

During December 2014, a remarkable high number of the form 'application for admission to the doctoral program' has been submitted to the registrar's office.

Application forms that have been submitted before the 31st of December 2014 are evaluated consistent with the doctorate regulations, as applied during that time period.

The registrar's office registers the application forms in order of arrival sequence.

Furthermore, due to the high number of applications, processing the forms will take longer than it normally would.

Note: some application forms belong to PhD-students, who expect to defend their thesis within a few months.

If those PhD-students did not hear from the registrar's office anytime soon, we would kindly invite you to contact the registrar's office directly.
