The last few months have been largely dominated by the bursary experiment proposed last week by the Dutch minister of Education, Culture and Science, Jet Bussemaker. This experiment would entail that 2000 PhD-candidates would be considered students instead of employees. PNN (the PhD Candidate Network of the Netherlands) drafted a letter providing strong arguments against this bursary experiment. This letter has been signed by members of university councils, works councils and representatives of local and national PhD organisations, amongst others ProVU and the Works Council of the VU University. The letter has been provided on February 24, 2015 to the Executive boards and Boards of directors of all Dutch universities and university medical centers to stress our mutual concerns about the experiment.

Please make sure you fill out your form 1 before April 1st 2015

From the registrar's office (bureau pedel)

During December 2014, a remarkable high number of the form 'application for admission to the doctoral program' has been submitted to the registrar's office.

Application forms that have been submitted before the 31st of December 2014 are evaluated consistent with the doctorate regulations, as applied during that time period.

The registrar's office registers the application forms in order of arrival sequence.

Furthermore, due to the high number of applications, processing the forms will take longer than it normally would.

Note: some application forms belong to PhD-students, who expect to defend their thesis within a few months.

If those PhD-students did not hear from the registrar's office anytime soon, we would kindly invite you to contact the registrar's office directly.

If you really want to see this play, we urge you to register **as soon as possible**. Important message for international students: unfortunately this play and the discussion will be in Dutch.


